- \$555,936 operating cash: a good / solid working number for ongoing balance
- Designated cash accounts a notation will be added to bottom of the balance sheet for LPS funds
- Cap Campaign Funds: Of the \$1,079,557, \$1 million has been moved to a Raymond James account; \$79,557 remains in the First Horizon account

Pledges up considerably over Budget

Discussion of Earthquake Insurance ... Church insurance will cover us up to \$500k, with deductible of \$50k . . . Our insurance agent is shopping for additional coverage . . . \$500k would kick in first in case of earthquake . . . Vestry will need to have ongoing / philosophical discussions about policies / rebuilding, etc . . . Suggestion made we have conversations with UofM Earthquake center . . . Current policy expires in August, so decisions must be made soon!

Overall Capital Campaign and Construction Update

- May 21 or May 28 will be last Sunday in the Church... Will most probably be 5.21
- 5/28 Pentecost First Sunday in Orgill Room...
- Addition of 5:30 service on Sundays
- Four-month process Church finished by October... Then move to remaining portions of the buildings... Memos will come in the next week or so detailing which offices / facilities / etc., will move where and for how long
- Discussions of worship locations and seating capacity (per the Fire Marshall)...
 Orgill Room; Great Hall; possible addition of a 5:30 service... Thoughts related to informality of summer and use of parks for evening service; also possibility of having a big screen in an overflow room (i.e., meet in Great Hall, with overflow in Orgill or vice versa)... Once we're back in the church in October, Formation may happen in the Grizzlies 5th grade building
- Terri reminded us Room in the Inn will be happening throughout the summer
- Sunday School will have a delayed start after Labor Day rather than August
- Organ Crawl after church on April 30 Organ project will take 18 months . . .
 Portions will be back hopefully by Christmas . . .
- Ongoing discussions of how we can help people stay connected . . . Use of Construction Cams . . . Calvary Hardhats . . . Create timelapse video of entire process
