Lindisfarne or Holy Island is famed as the birthplace of English Christianity. A 3-mile causeway connects the island with the mainland at low tide and we will cross during the six hour spell between tides.





Beamish is the first regional open-air museum, in England, which brings the history of North East England to life at its 1820s terraced garden, 1900s Town, 1900s Pit Village, 1940s Farm, 1950s Town and 1950s Spain's Field Farm exhibit areas.



A gorgeous French chateau, Bowes Museum was built to house the art collection of John Bowes and his wife Joséphine Benoîte Coffin-Chevallier, and opened in 1892.



Alnwick Castle, the main seat of the current 12th Duke of Northumberland, is a great border castle dating back to 1309 whose walls enclose 7 acres of beautiful park.



Hadrian's Wall is the most important monument built by the Romans in 122 AD. Housesteads Fort (Vercovicium) is possibly the remains of the most complete Roman fort in Britain.
